

<p><b>On Field Injury</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Athlete presents with signs or symptoms of concussion</li> <li>• ATC or Coach removes athlete from play immediately</li> <li>• Athlete is released to parent/guardian for medical attention (athlete may NOT drive)</li> <li>• Athlete <b>MUST</b> be cleared to play by primary care physician or specialist</li> <li>• Physician's release given to AD or ATC (ATC notified if given to AD)</li> <li>• Athlete is scheduled for Post ImPACT test within 24-72 hours of release by physician</li> <li>• Post ImPACT test is reviewed by ATC and TCPS Medical Director</li> </ul>
<p><b>Post ImPACT Test Passed</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ATC will notify Coach and AD of passed test</li> <li>• AD will notify parent or guardian of passed test and the start of the Gradual Return to Play protocol already in place by TCPS (if parent asks, a copy of the post test will be given)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Post ImPACT Test Failed (1)</b> (ATC and TCPS Medical Director will review Post ImPACT test)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ATC will notify Coach and AD of failed test</li> <li>• AD notifies parent or guardian and Coach of failed test and a re-test date along with a copy of the failed test</li> <li>• *AD will re-test in 7 days* (this time frame was given to us by panel of experts)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Re-test (1) Passed</b> (ATC and TCPS Medical Director will review Post ImPACT test)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ATC will notify Coach and AD of <b>PASSED</b> test</li> <li>• AD will notify parent or guardian of passed test and the start of the Gradual Return to Play protocol already in place by TCPS (if parent asks a copy of both failed and passed post test will be given)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Re-test (1) Failed</b> (ATC and TCPS Medical Director will review Re-Test (1))</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ATC will notify Coach and AD of <b>FAILED</b> test</li> <li>• AD notifies parent or guardian of failed test. A copy of the failed test is given to parent or guardian along with note that athlete needs to be <b>referred back to treating physician</b> (treating physician= primary care doctor or concussion specialist)</li> <li>• Athlete is under care of treating physician</li> <li>• Athlete is released by treating physician, note is given to Coach, AD, or ATC (if ATC is not given note, then notify ATC of release)</li> <li>• Athlete is scheduled for re-test (2) within 24-72 hours of written release</li> </ul>
<p><b>Re-test (2) Passed</b> (ATC and TCPS Medical Director will review Re-test (2))</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ATC will notify Coach and AD of <b>passed</b> test</li> <li>• AD notifies parent or guardian of passed test and the start of the Gradual Return to Play protocol already in place by TCPS (if parent asks a copy of both failed and passed post test will be given)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Re-test (2) Failed</b> (ATC and TCPS Medical Director will review Re-test (2))</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ATC will notify Coach and AD of <b>failed</b> test</li> <li>• AD notifies parent or guardian of failed test. A copy of the failed test is given to parent or guardian along with note that athlete needs to be <b>referred back to treating physician</b> (treating physician= primary care doctor or concussion specialist)</li> <li>• Athlete is under care of treating physician</li> </ul>
