ASSIST EQUIP SUPPORT

Unaccompanied Homeless Youth are young adults ages 18-24, experiencing homelessness who are not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.

Millions of young adults experience homelessness each year. Homelessness among unaccompanied youth can be associated with severe family dysfunction, poor mental health and poverty. Youth without basic life skills and education are more likely to experience homelessness, substance abuse, sexual abuse and violence.

ASSIST:

With existing programs like RRH, HP, and collaborations with Transitional Housing, local landlords and State Funded housing we can assist UY with getting into housing and off the streets.
