Leadership

- Exemplifies positive attitudes
- Demonstrates great leadership skills in the classroom, at work, and in the school or community

- Is willing to represent the school

Character

- Upholds principles of morality and ethics
- Cooperates by complying with school regulation including not receiving any referrals to the office
- Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty
- Listens to instructions and rules both inside and outside the classroom
- Shows good attendance

Citizenship

- Participates in scouting, community activities, and school clubs

Scholarship

- Shows great academic skills
- Must keep a minimum grade point average of a 85% from grades 6 – 8

Expectations of Members in Good Standing

1. Students will keep their cumulative grade point average at or above an 85%.
2. Students will exemplify the standards of Character, Service, Leadership, and Citizenship.
3. Students will participate in one (1) group service project per semester.
4. Students will submit one (1) individual service project per year.
